## RESOLUTION NO. 147 OF 2022: FILL THE POSITION OF ACCOUNT CLERK

**WHEREAS**, the Town Clerk has advertised for the position of Account Clerk as per Resolution No. 129 of 2022, and

WHEREAS, a qualified candidate has applied for the position, and

**WHEREAS**, the FY 2022 Budget has appropriated funds for a person to fill in for the Bookkeeper in anticipation of the Bookkeepers reduced work schedule,

**BE IT RESOLVED**, the Town Board hereby approves the hire Carrie-Jo Hoffman to fill the position of Account Clerk as permanent part time at no more than 15 hours per week at a rate of \$17 per hour to be paid from A1220.13 Backup Bookkeeper on a provisional basis with a 6-month probationary period.
